3- The trustees shall irrevocably hold and stand possessed of the said money all of which are hereinafter for brevity's sake referred to as "The Trust Fund" which expression shall also include cash and other properties movable or immovable and investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof may be converted, invested or varied from time to time or such as may be acquired by the Trustees or come to their hands by virtue of those present as donations, bequests, endowments or by operation of law or otherwise, howsoever, in relation to those present, upon the Trusts and with and subject to the powers contained of and concerning the same.

4- It shall be lawful for the trustees to receive by way of gifts, bequests, donations, contributions and legacies from any person(s), firm(s), association(s), trust(s) or corporate bodies whether towards the corpus of the Trust or otherwise for all or any purpose of the trust herein created upon and or subject to such special conditions as may be attached thereto but not in any way at variance with the purposes or objects of this trust, and to retain any investments or other properties so received as an addition to the trust if so required as a condition and to apply the same upon or subject to such conditions but otherwise in accordance with the provisions herein contained.

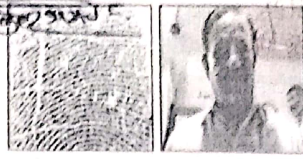

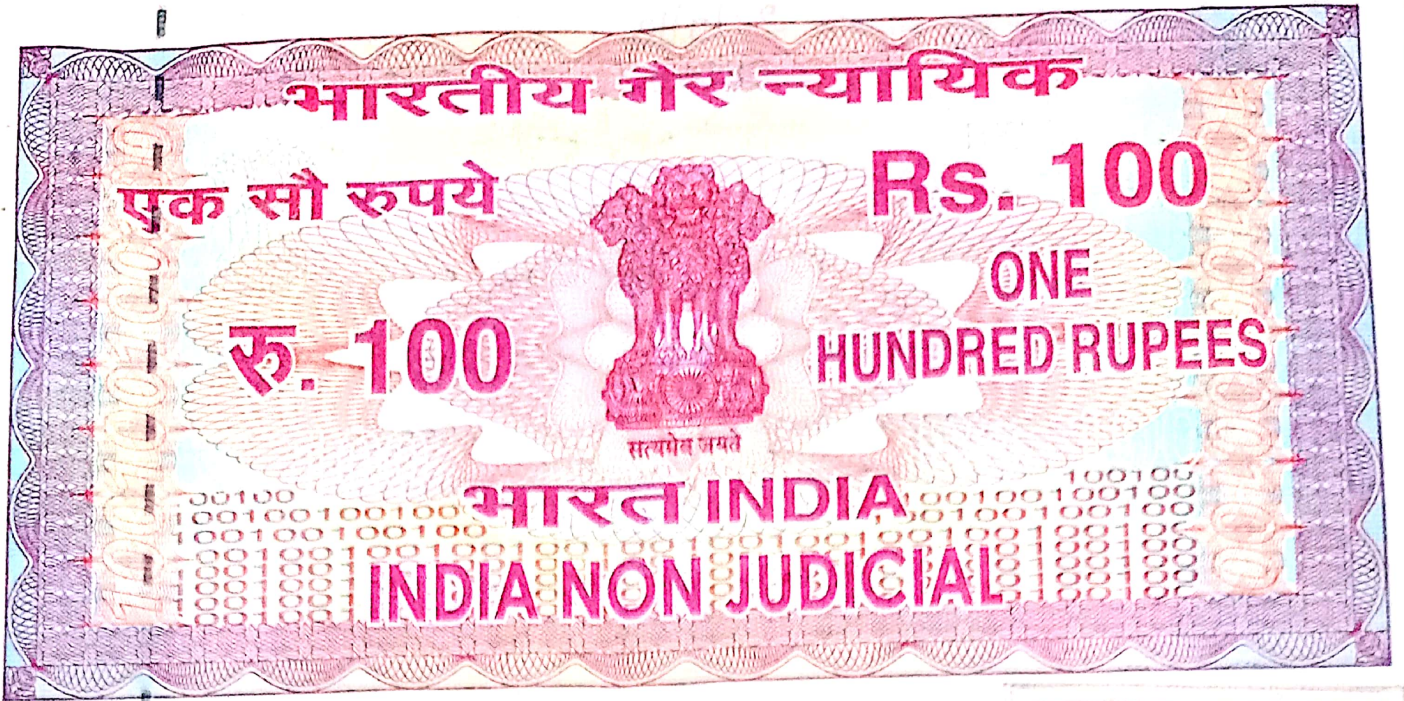

**OBJECTS OF THE TRUST**

1- The trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the trust fund and the income thereof as follows:-

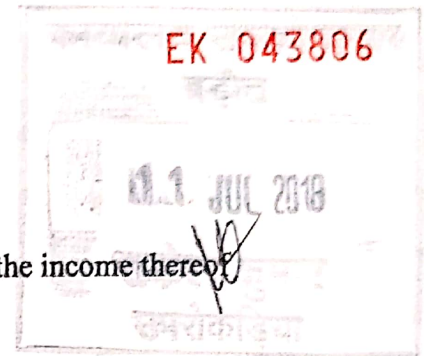
A- To invest the trust fund or corpus that may from time to time acquired for investment in any investments not forbidden by law;

B- To manage the trust fund or corpus and collect and recover the interest, dividends and other income thereof:

C- To pay out of the income of the trust properties(Trust fund or corpus) in the first place all costs and expenses of or incidental to the management of the Trust and the income thereof or the execution of any of the trusts or power of those present.

D- To pay, utilize or apply the net income of the Trust fund or corpus, after meeting out all expenses as provided in those present and in the discretion of the trustees as corpus of the trust fund or any part of the corpus in India for such purposes including .

- Relief of the poor;
- Spread of Education;
- Medical Relief;
- Advancement of any other object of general public utility not involving the carrying on any activity for profit as the law (including tax laws) and any other law for the time being in force may regard as public educational purposes, as the trustees may think fit and for one or more of such objects or purposes to the exclusion of other or others as the trustees may think fit.
- Take loan from with or without interest from trustees or any other person(s), firm(s), company/companies or in any other manner.

Provided that the income as well as the corpus shall be applied only towards public charitable and educational purposes as aforesaid accumulation of income if any, shall also be deemed to be made for application to such public educational and charitable purposes as foresaid.

2- Subject to and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing objects or purposes, it is declared that the trustees shall each year from time to time at their discretion apply the trust income and corpus or any part or parts of the same in or towards any one or more of the following objects (each of which according to law, must be a educational object) to the exclusion of the other of them in such manner in all respects as the trustees may in their absolute discretion think proper.

I- To spread or promote education or learning in all its branches in such manner as the trustees may think fir including

A- Establishment and or acquisition and maintenance and support of schools, colleges, vidyapeeths, balmandirs, study centres, universities and other institutions for imparting education and training of students.



B- Establishment of college, institute for Diploma, Degree course of paramedical, medical, technical, and management courses.

C- Establishment and support of scholarships and prizes at any school, college or other educational institutions.

D- Establishment and maintenance and support of hostels and or boarding houses and grants of free boarding and lodging to poor deserving students or at or below cost upon such terms and for such period in each case as the trustees may deem fit.

E- Grant of endowments to universities, research institutions and other educational and study institutions (whether now existing or hereafter establishment) for spreading of education and knowledge in all or any branches of knowledge.

F- Awarding scholarships and cash payment to poor persons and widows desirous of receiving primary, secondary and higher education

II - Affording of medical and poverty relief in such manner as the trustees may think fit including:-

A- Establishment and or acquisition and grant of subscriptions and donations to hospitals, dispensaries, convalescent homes, nursing homes, orphanages, eye centres, moving dispensaries and other public or other institutions for administering medical relief to the needy upon such conditions, free or concessional and for such period as the trustees may think fit.

III- Distribution of free food and clothing to poor and needy.

IV- Setting up or helping by endowments or otherwise institutions for the benefits of the widows, disabled and old persons.

V- Establishing or rendering help to any institutions for the alleviation of human sufferings.





- VI- Sinking of wells and or setting up "piaos" whenever and wherever there may be scarcity of water.
- VII- Subscriptions, contributions and or donations to any public funds or institutions for promotion of public charitable objects.
- VIII- Establishment, maintenance and support of libraries, museums and reading rooms for advancements of education and knowledge in general.
- IX- To grant sportsman, encourage body building and help vyayam shalas.
- X- To publish books, charts, journals and periodicals, etc for the development and attainment of the aims and objects of the trust.

PROVIDED ALWAYS also without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing that the help given under any of the foregoing heads whenever the case admits may be given either in the way of pecuniary payments or supply of provisions, food or clothing or distributions of the medical relief or in any manner which the trustees may consider desirable.

7- That THE SETTLER so long as he is alive and after him, the board of trustees shall have power by supplementary declaration(s), resolutions of the board to amend, delete or alter any of the objects set out hereinabove or any matter provided in this deed, only in so far as and only to the extent such amendments, declarations or deletions be required by commissioner of the income tax or any other competent tax authority in order that the trust be eligible and continue to be eligible for the various exemptions and privileges granted to public charitable trusts under the income tax act and or any other laws for the time being in force.

8- The objects of the trust shall be carried out and income shall be applied to such objects and purposes in India.




**BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND IT'S POWERS**

A- The management and control of the trust properties shall vest in the board of trustees. The board of trustees shall comprise as number of members as desired or decided by the board of trustees. The following shall be first trustees:-

B- The board of trustees will have the full powers to regulate and manage the affairs of the trust and any other institutions as it may establish pursuant to those present.

C- The board of trustees shall have regular president and in his absence a president will be elected at such meeting who shall be member of the board of trustees.

D- Meeting of board of trustees will be held as often as may be necessary from time to time in accordance with the requirements of business in this behalf, PROVIDED a meeting of board of trustees shall be held at least every one year. Reasonable advance notice shall be given to each trustee.

E- The trustees shall be entitled to salaries and other allowances to such an extent as decided by the board of trustees. Those allowances may be:-




- Medical
- Travelling
- Telephone
- Office
- And others as may be decided by the board of trustees.

F- Meeting of the Board of Trustees will be held as often as may be necessary from time to time in accordance with the requirements of business in this behalf, PROVIDED a meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held at least every 12 months . Reasonable advance notice shall be given to each Trustee.


G- One third of member of trustees but not less than three shall form a quorum for meetings of trustees provided, however, if the number of trustees falls below two then for the purpose of appointing a trustee, one will form the quorum.

H- Every member shall be determined by majority of the trustees present and voting.

I- Any resolution of the board of trustees circulated to all the trustees who may be in India and approved by at least one third of them shall be valid and effectual as it had been passed at a meeting of the board of trustees.

10- The trustees or board of trustees present may reimburse and pay out of the funds or moneys in their hands all the expenses incurred in or about the execution of the trust's actions. The trustees may also be paid actual travelling expenses for attending the meeting of trust or its subcommittees.

11- The trustees shall have power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of these presents be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoings shall or sought to be





paid and or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive. PROVIDED that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize the trustees to spend the income or corpus of the trust fund for any purposes not authorized by those present.

12- The board of trusts may from time to time prescribe further rules and by laws for the governance of the trust and of any of the institutions as it may establish pursuant to those present and as to the management and administrations thereof and as to the meetings of the trustees, the mode of convening the same and the conduct of business thereof and otherwise as it may think fit may also delegate any powers and duties to any committee or committees consisting of such of the trustees and outsiders as they may appoint for such purposes and may at their discretion amend such rules.

13- In addition to all the powers hereby conferred on them and without detracting from the generality of the powers, the board of trustees shall have the following powers:-

A- To expand and or invest the funds of the trust in such manner as they shall in their absolute discretion consider most beneficial for the purpose of the trust(including investment in shares, securities, fixed and other deposits, movable and immovable properties and any other category of investments) PROVIDED that any of the above modes of investment are not forbidden by any law for the time being in force in the union off India and subject ti provisions hereof, as they may deem fit and to direct the sale or transposition of any such investments and do expand the proceeds of any such sale for the purpose of trust.

B- To acquire in the name of the trust or the board of trustees, build upon, pull down, rebuild, add to, alter, improve, sell, let out on rent, exchange or dispose off, or otherwise deal with such buildings or premises for the purpose of trust.





C- To purchase, hold or sell any kind of equipment for the purposes of trust.

D- To enter into contracts authorized by those present on behalf of the trust and to secure the fulfilment of any such contracts, or arrangements.

E- To borrow for the purpose authorized by those present, money for security of any of the trust and to grant or direct to be granted mortgages for securing the same.

F- To make, and from time to time repeal or alter regulations for efficient management of the trust and the affairs thereof and as to the duties of the honorary or salaried secretary, or secretaries, officers or servants of the trust and as to the conduct of business by the committee of management or any subcommittee or any of the matters or things within the powers or under the control of the committee of the management, PROVIDED that the same shall not be inconsistent with the object of the trust.

G- To pay all the premiums, revenues, rents, municipal rates, taxes, other charges and outgoing payable in respect of the trust properties.

H- To use and take lawful ways and means for recovery of money due to the trust or for realization of any security or other properties movable or immovable belonging to the trust and to settle, adjust, compound, submit to arbitration, direct to withdraw actions, accounts claims, demands, whatsoever, whether arising from legal proceedings or not.

I- To employ any staff as may be necessary for the administration and management of the trust properties and of the institutions established by pursuant to those present and to pay their salaries and at their discretion to remove such staff. to pay audit fees and incur all other necessary charges and expenses for administration and management of the trust and institutions there under,





J- To sign, endorse and negotiate cheques, bill of exchange drafts, debentures, G.P. Notes and other government and semi government, local or public loans papers and instruments, and so ask, command, draw, realize, collect, compound sign, endorse, negotiate all interests, dividends, warrants, bonuses and other benefits to acquire in respect of the trust properties and the investments thereof.

K- To delegate at their pleasure all or any of the powers to any individual or a subcommittee or committees and to vary and or revoke such delegations.

L- The board of trustees may from time to time open and maintain in its name or in the name of any one or more trustees bank account or bank account at such bank(s) as it shall from time to time decide and may at any time pay or cause to be paid any money of the trust to credit of any such account(s) or close or cause to be closed the same on deposit with any banker(s) and to withdraw money from such account(s).

14- The trustees shall be at liberty to retire from the trust voluntarily and he or she shall be disqualified to hold his or her office and he or she shall accordingly vacate his or her office if he or she becomes or is declared bankrupt or insolvent or lunatic or becomes of unsound mind. Provided further that a trustee shall also retire if so requested in writing by all other trustees for the time being in office and also constituting the majority of board.

15- No trustee shall be liable for any loss not attributable:-

A- To their dishonesty.

B- To wilful omission by them of any act known by them to be breach of trust and in particular shall not be bound to take any proceedings against co-trustee for any breach of trust committed by such trustees, nor shall they be trustees for value not received or realized by them although they may have signed for receipt thereof jointly with the trustees for the sake of conformity or otherwise.

16- The board of trustees shall cause to be kept proper books of accounts in respect to the sums or money received and expended by the trustees and all the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenses, relate to and all the properties for the time being vested in them and for all liabilities in connection therewith.

17- The balance sheet and income and expenditure account of the trustees shall be prepared and audited once at least after every years by a recognized firm of chartered accountants and auditors to be appointed by the trustees and laid before the board of trustees at a meeting to be held as far as possible not later than 9 months of the date up to such accounts have been made.

18 - Any notice to be given to the trustees to those present shall be given sufficient time, if sent through registered post addressed to such trustees at their usual or last known place abode, business in India.

19- Subject to aforesaid, the board of trustees may from time to time make and alter such regulations and provisions with regard to conduct of its business and with regard to any subsidiary or procedural matters in respect thereof which it may think proper.
